BARISSE GRIFFIN BUTTERFIELD POST-GRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT **\$25,000**

The Butterfield post-graduate scholarship is available to students in all ten Butterfield jurisdictions around the world who are studying disciplines related to the preservation and improvement of island environments at accredited institutions. The award has an annual value of \$25,000, tenable for up to four years.

The 2019 recipient Barisse Griffin, from The Bahamas, is currently enrolled at King's College in London, UK where she is pursuing a master's degree in Disasters, Adaption and Development Management. Barisse says, "throughout the Caribbean we are

experiencing unfamiliar climate patterns, such as prolonged and repeated droughts, intense rainfall, and rising sea levels. These conditions disrupt our marine environments and coastal areas, resulting in pollutants and debris drifting into the sea, and rising seas consuming our beaches." Barisse's goal is to develop strategies that will improve crisis response throughout The Bahamas and the Caribbean, helping to combat natural disasters and protect the islands.
